<p>During the reporting period for this grant Children’s Association for Maximum Potential (CAMP) provided:</p> <p><b>Summer Programs</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Nine distinct one-week residential sessions <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Offered from May through August</li> <li>• Camp in Center Point, Texas</li> </ul> </li> <li>➤ 847 children attended (unduplicated participants) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 458 (54%) from KCF counties of interest</li> </ul> </li> <li>➤ 523 volunteer counselors</li> <li>➤ 171 Health Care volunteers</li> <li>➤ 76 summer lead staff</li> <li>➤ Total of 206,511 hours of service</li> </ul> <p><b>School-year Programs</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Respite Weekends -- Nine monthly weekend camps</li> <li>➤ Parent’s Night Out -- Nine monthly evening events</li> <li>➤ Teen and Adult Day Adventure -- Social and recreational events for individuals with special needs (sporting events, amusement park, etc.)</li> <li>➤ 161 individuals attended (duplicated participants) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 124 (77%) from KCF counties of interest</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p>A <b>Parent Survey</b> was conducted to determine if the programs were meeting the needs of children with medical, physical, developmental, and intellectual disabilities. Questions and results included:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ How did your CAMPer feel about self? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 82% felt better</li> <li>• 5% felt the same</li> <li>• 13% unable to determine</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	

- How did experience affect CAMPer's independence and self-confidence?
  - 67% more
  - 20% no change
  - 1% less
  - 12% unable to determine
- Grade the experience for CAMPer:
  - 93% A (sic)
  - 8% B (sic)
  - 1.5% C (sic)
  - 0.5% D (sic)
- Grade the experience for Family:
  - 86% A
  - 12% B
  - 1% C
- Respite Weekends allowed my child to have a fun camping experience
  - 96% Strongly Agree or Agree
  - 4% Unable to determine
- Respite events relieved stress and helped us cope with our caregiving responsibilities
  - 92% Strongly Agree or Agree
  - 7.5% Unable to determine
- The educationally enriched activities at Parents Night Out are beneficial for my child
  - 89% Strongly Agree or Agree
  - 11% Unable to determine
