GRANT OBJECTIVES: For home delivered meals seniors and disabled citizens will be able to remain independent in their homes and will maintain and enhance their nutritional levels. Congregate meal participants will have the opportunity to lead a healthier life through nutrition and socializing and will also have the opportunity to participate in physical and mental exercises.

<p>During the reporting period for this grant the Comal County Senior Citizens Foundation (CCSF) experienced significant growth in its programs:</p> <p>Senior Nutrition Program</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ 771 seniors served (goal was 650) ➤ Meals served and/or delivered daily (five days per week) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 62,808 home delivered meals • 24,980 congregate meals • 7,570 meals for Bulverde Senior Center ➤ Frozen meals delivered to homebound clients on Fridays and Holidays ➤ Client satisfaction surveys were consistently positive with occasional reference to personal food likes/dislikes <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 31% rated meals as excellent • 63% rated meals as good • 3% rated meals as fair • 3% rated meals as poor <p>My Friends Haus had an average daily attendance of 47 clients.</p> <p>Administrative Accomplishments/Challenges</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ New executive director in June 2015 ➤ Board of Directors voted to rehabilitate the present location in lieu of seeking a new site and building a new building ➤ Terminated the Hospital Readmission Prevention Program
